Since receiving the 15-acre horse farm a year ago, Empower Youth successfully converted one building into a packing facility where volunteers now assemble over 600 weekend food packs weekly for distribution at five school districts in three counties. Additionally, major cleanup work was done throughout the property and other buildings were torn down. All this was performed by a network of volunteers committed to breaking the chains of poverty.

The 2018 Building Fund will focus on four areas:

1. Renovated long barn into a grand hall to host community groups, receptions, poverty education and service learning workshops
2. Improvements to the parking area and driveway
3. A new septic system
4. Manager's quarters

According to Empower Youth executive director, Lori Conley "the commitment from Community Savings Bank and a \$50,000 grant from the State of Ohio puts this dream within reach".
